

## A Glorious Secret Genesis 42

### Typology:

Joseph = Jesus

Joseph's 10 half-brothers = Israel / The Law

7 years of plenty / famine = The 70<sup>th</sup> week of Daniel

Bread / Grain = Salvation

Benjamin = The Jewish Remnant (e.g. the Apostle Paul)

*“His blood be on us and on our children.” - Matthew 27:25 (the Jewish crowd to Pontius Pilate, speaking of having Jesus crucified)*

How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing! See! Your house is left to you desolate; for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’”*

*- Matthew 23:37-39 (Jesus weeping over Jerusalem / Israel)*

Simeon = “hearing with acceptance”

*“Therefore I speak to them in parables, because seeing they do not see, and hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand. And in them the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled, which says: ‘Hearing you will hear and shall not understand, and seeing you will see and not perceive; for the hearts of this people have grown dull...’”*

*- Matthew 13:13-15 (Jesus speaking of the Jewish people)*

*And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. - Romans 8:28*

*...If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? - Romans 8:31-32*
