PAUL'S CALL:

Acts 26:12-18 > Jesus reveals Himself to Paul and calls him to ministry

- Acts 9:10-15 > God reveals Paul's calling to Ananias
- Acts 22:17-21 > God tells Paul, "Go now"
- "Goad": A pointy stick used by farmers to poke the back of oxen's legs to keep them moving forward.
- Paul is emphatically _____ (sent) to the Gentiles, with the message of Jesus.

THE EIGHT DISPENSATIONS IN SCRIPTURE:

"Dispensation": A way in which God relates to us.

- 1) The Dispensation of > From Creation to the Fall of Man
 - > Man still chooses to disobey God
- 2) The Dispensation of Conscience > From the Fall of Man to the Flood (1,650 years)
 - > Produces epidemic mass perversion

- 3) The Dispensation of _____
 - > From the Flood to the Tower of Babel (425 years)
 - > Man rejects God and focuses on self
- 4) The Dispensation of Promise
 - > From Abraham to the Exodus (430 years)
 - > Man forgets the promise and ends up in bondage
- 5) The Dispensation of _____
 - > From the Exodus to the Cross (1,500 years)
 - > Man is unable to keep the Law
- 6) The Dispensation of Grace
 - > The age in which we live
 - > We relate to God through
- The Dispensation of _____ > Future 7-year period (Revelation 6-19) > Man still runs from God
- 8) The Dispensation of Righteousness > Future 1,000-year period following the Tribulation > Some still rebel against God at the end
