

## I Am Jesus: Do You Want To Be Made Well? John 5:1-16

**V.2:** The Bethesda pool is a picture of \_\_\_\_\_.

“Bethesda” = “house of mercy”

**V.4** explains the local belief at the time.

“pool” = *Kolumbethra* (Greek for “a deep pool from underneath that comes bubbling”)

The essence of the Gospel is “God \_\_\_\_\_ those who \_\_\_\_\_ themselves”.

**V.5:** *Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, “See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you.”*  
– John 5:14
