Exodus 5:1-6:8**

“Why this waste? For this fragrant oil might have been sold for much and given to the poor.” - Matthew 26:8-9 (Judas Iscariot responding to Mary’s anointing of Jesus)

In John 17:12, Jesus refers to Judas as “the son of perdition”. The original Greek word translated “perdition” (apōleia) means “waste”.
